



## Ballarat Cricket Association Governing Procedure 10 BCA Hall of Fame

### BCA HALL OF FAME

The Ballarat Cricket Hall of Fame was conceived by the BCA Board in 2015 to honour Ballarat's legendary cricketers and contributors. New members may be inducted every year at the BCA Awards Night or an appropriate event selected by the BCA Board at the time.

The Ballarat Cricket Associations Hall of Fame seeks to recognise and enshrine players, coaches, umpires, administrators and representatives, volunteers and media representatives who have made significant contributions to Ballarat Cricket since its inception in 1895.

Any person or organisation may make nominations annually to the BCA for consideration by the Selection Committee. The nomination should have a seconded nominator. Nominations are to be submitted annually by the **30th of June**.

### SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Hall of Fame selection Committee will consist of one or two Board Members (other than the Executive Officer) of the Association and 1 current Hall of Fame member to a maximum of 3 Committee Members.

Should there be more than one nomination, then each should be considered in turn with a preliminary discussion to determine which nomination is to take precedent by the selection committee. This preliminary discussion is merely a way to determine which nomination outweighs the others.

In the unusual circumstance where the Committee considers more than one nomination is worthy, the Committee may determine that 2 Hall of Fames are awarded. However, this must be only in extremely special circumstances, and no more than two can be awarded in any single year.

Any nomination which has previously been submitted, but not selected, may be reconsidered by the Selection Committee

The Board Representative from the Committee shall take the nomination/s to the Board for a final decision.



All Committee members should be aware that it is not necessary for a Hall of Fame Membership to be granted each year.

The selection committee considers candidates based on record, ability, integrity, sportsmanship and character and the below criteria. The number of games played, coached or umpired or years of service above the qualification is a consideration only and does not determine eligibility.

### Criteria for induction to the BCA Hall of Fame

The following criteria is referred to for induction into the hall of fame:

- A player must be considered as generally retired from the game for at least 12 months
- Played any juniors or seniors in the BCA
- The person must have impacted / contributed in some way in which the game is played, through playing, officiating, representation, development programs, administration, coaching, supporting, umpiring, volunteering, community or reporting at club and association level.
- Nominee should have played / officiated / administered or coached / supported or reported at least a minimum of 150 (approx 10 years) officially sanctioned BCA matches / games or made at least 5000 runs or taken at least 150 wickets or 150 catches / stumpings.
  - This is a minimum expectation for someone who has played as a 1st XI player (male or female) at their club or clubs
- The Hall of Fame seeks to honour players from all eras, who have played and or represented in the BCA across different formats of the game i.e. junior /senior / club level, association representation (country week), Melbourne premier, state or international levels (junior or senior, state, Test, ODI, T20).
- Awards, honours, or recognition received by the nominee from club, association (e.g. Cleary medal), and state, national and community level will be considered.
- A nominee's individual achievements, integrity, sportsmanship and character will be considered. (not been suspended for poor behaviour)

The club / nominator could use the following guidelines help present the case:

1. A player must be considered as generally retired from the game for at least 12 months
2. Played any juniors or seniors in the BCA
